
## Kindergarten Registration

We are looking for Kindergarteners for the upcoming 2017-2018 school year. If you have a child that will be attending school in the fall as a kindergartener, please come in and register for the 2017-2018 school year. We will accept packets April 10th through May 25th. Parents may register children at their neighborhood elementary campus during this time. Any child who will be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2017, and who resides in the Mabank ISD area is eligible to attend the district's full-day kindergarten.

### Dress Code Reminder

As we approach warmer weather, we would like to remind parents and students that MISD does have a district dress code that is enforced. The following items are not allowed to be worn at school: mini skirts, halter tops, tube tops, backless shirts, short shorts/skirts, biker shorts, or tank or spaghetti strap shirts unless they are worn with a sleeved shirt over it or under it (layers). Acceptable length of shorts and skirts is defined as reaching mid-thigh between to of the thigh and the top of the knee. Girls may wear leggings but must have school appropriate shorts or skirts over them.
