"What would you do if you found a pot of gold at the end of the rainbow?"

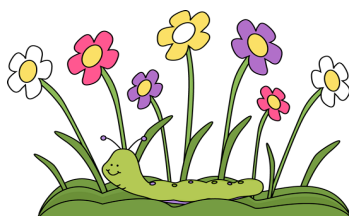
Savannah Phillips (3rd): "I would give it to the community that needs it."

4th Grade Writing

March 28th

On Tuesday, March 28th fourth grade students will take the STAAR Writing test. The 4th grade writing test will be taken in one day with a four hour time limit. To help your child be at their best on testing day, please make sure they get plenty of sleep the night before testing. Ensure they have a good breakfast at home, or arrive at school in plenty of time to eat their morning meal (by 7:45am). Encourage your child to do their best and assure him/her they can be successful! **The 3rd and 4th grade Reading and Math STAAR tests will take place on May 8th (math) and May 9th (reading).** ****Please make sure that any doctor visits or appointments are not scheduled on these dates. To provide students with the best testing environment, we will not be hosting lunch visitors on testing days.
