Lunch Visitor Procedures

If your child will be having a lunch visitor during their designated lunch time, the visitor must be listed on your child's registration card as an approved visitor/emergency contact. If the visitor is not listed on their card, they will not be allowed to eat lunch with your child. The visitor is also required to show valid identification. We allow visitors at lunch only, not breakfast due to limited time in the morning. As always, visitors must report to the office and sign in before attending lunch or any other campus event.

Transportation

ALL transportations changes must be made prior to 2:30 pm. Transportation changes cannot be made after 2:30 pm., except for emergency situations.
