- 2. Plan and complete construction of cabinets, shelves, and partitions from initial layout to assembly following oral instructions, plans, specifications, blueprints, and work orders.
- 3. Select material and hardware and calculate time and materials estimates.
- 4. Assist with the installation and moving of portable buildings including constructing steps and installing underpinning.
- 5. Receive and complete work orders. Respond to emergency calls as needed.
- 6. Maintain accurate records on material and labor used.

- 8. Maintain inventory of district-owned tools, equipment, and materials.
- 9. Work with building principals and supervisors to schedule and complete projects.
