Also, in April, our students continue preparations to take the math and reading STAAR tests. **Fourth grade students will take the Writing STAAR on Tuesday, April 10th.** Our third and fourth grade students are gearing up to take the Math and Reading STAAR tests on May 14th and 15th. We're confident that Lakeview students will, once again, do their very best and be ROCK-STAARS!

As always, you can help your child achieve their best by ensuring they get plenty of rest the night before the test. This is especially important now that daylight savings time has gone into effect. Even though the days are longer, the school year is not over, and students must not quit. ## Kindergarten Registration

We are looking for Kindergarteners for the upcoming 2018-2019 school year. If you have a child that will be attending school in the fall as a kindergartener, please come in and register for the 2018-2019 school year. We will accept packets April 9th through May 25th. Parents may register children at their neighborhood elementary campus during this time. Any child who will be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2018, and who reside in the Mabank ISD area is eligible to attend the district's full-day kindergarten.



## Dress Code Reminder

As we approach warmer weather, we would like to remind parents and students that MISD does have a district dress code that is enforced. The following items are not allowed to be worn at school: mini skirts, halter tops, tube tops, backless shirts, short shorts/skirts, biker shorts, or tank or spaghetti strap shirts unless they are worn with a sleeved shirt over it or under it (layers). Acceptable length of shorts and skirts is defined as reaching mid-thigh between top of the thigh and the top of the knee. Girls may wear leggings but must have school appropriate shorts or skirts over them. Hair may not be spiked, have designs shaved next to the scalp, or be dyed or bleached a color unnatural to hair colors. Boys may not have mohawks or faux-hawks.
